TASK 1

- 3. Essence of story line.
- 4. Main object.

Example: The dentist's waiting room

- 1. Setting: A dentist's waiting room.
- 2. Main character: Brian, a nervous patient.
- 3. Essence of story line: Brian becomes increasingly nervous as he waits in the waiting room and desperately thinks of an excuse to leave.
- 4. Main object: A huge bright orange umbrella.

Worked example of a story developed from the four elements:

The next patient came out from the dentist's room holding his cheek in much pain and Brian finally made up his mind that he was not going to stop. He would re-book his appointment! Being a coward at heart he felt that today was definitely not the day to suffer a painful filling. But what should he do? He glanced round at the other patients who were reading magazines and looking quite calm. Suddenly an idea occurred to him. He fiddled apparently casually with his huge, bright orange umbrella and 'accidentally' pressed the button which released the mechanism and the umbrella opened up. 'Oh no!' he exclaimed. He went over to the receptionist. 'I'm sorry about this, but I've done a stupid thing. My umbrella has accidentally opened indoors. I'm a terribly superstitious person and I couldn't possibly see the dentist now that this has happened. Could I, er, reappoint please – for another day?' He gave the receptionist a feeble smile.
